MEMBERSHIP OF THE BOARD

The Board shall consist of seven members. Any registered voter of a trustee area of the county is eligible to be a member of the county board of education representing the trustee area of which he or she is an elector, except the county superintendent of schools, any member of his or her staff, or any employee of a school district may not be a member of the county board of education. If any member of the county board of education is determined not to meet these criteria, the county board of education shall declare that member's position vacant and proceed to fill the vacancy as prescribed by law.

Each member shall live in the trustee area which he or she represents and shall be elected by the voters of that area in the manner prescribed by the Education and Elections Codes.

The trustee areas for the Board shall be constituted from the school districts in the county, as follows:

Trustee Area 1 - Palo Alto Unified; Mountain View-Whisman (and corresponding portions of Mountain View-Los Altos Union High); Sunnyvale (and corresponding portion of Fremont Union High)

Trustee Area 2 - Los Altos (and corresponding portion of Mountain View-Los Altos Union High); Cupertino Union, Montebello (and corresponding portions of Fremont Union High); Los Gatos Union, Saratoga Union, Lakeside Joint, Loma Prieta Joint Union (and Los Gatos-Saratoga Joint Union High)

Trustee Area 3 - Cambrian, Campbell Union, Luther Burbank, Moreland, Union, (and Campbell Union High)

Trustee Area 4 - San Jose Unified; Orchard (and corresponding portion of East Side Union High)

Trustee Area 5 - Milpitas Unified; Santa Clara Unified; Berryessa Union (and corresponding portion of East Side Union High)

Trustee Area 6 - Evergreen, Franklin-McKinley, Oak Grove (and corresponding portions of East Side Union High)

Trustee Area 7 - Gilroy Unified; Morgan Hill Unified; Alum Rock Union Elementary, Mount Pleasant (and corresponding portions of East Side Union High)

In addition to the elected members, a student representative may be appointed by the Board from among the high school students of Santa Clara County to serve as a non-voting representative to the Board.

To ensure that the trustee areas are as nearly equal in population as practicable, the Board shall review these trustee areas after each decennial federal census to determine if any modifications to current configurations are required.
